

Homeland Map Resolution

WHEREAS the Métis National Council has clearly and consistently defined the Métis Nation and its Homeland as the distinct Indigenous people and nation that emerged in the late 18th century with its own culture, language and political consciousness in that part of the historic Northwest encompassing today's Prairie Provinces (Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta), and contiguous regions of north-eastern British Columbia, the Northwest Territories, northwestern Ontario and the northern United States;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the General Assembly confirms the map below of the Homeland of the historic Métis Nation.
